Examination Results

2016 saw St Edmund's College students record excellent results of which we are very proud.

In fact, our A Level results were our best ever with 74% achieving A*-B grades with 44% of all grades awarded at A*/A.

We're delighted to record our first ever International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme results with students achieving an average point score of 33, putting us above the current world average of 30.07.

Our GCSE saw a slight increase over 2015 with A*- A grades at 36% with 65% achieving A*- B grades.

The Headmaster, Mr Durán, said "We are delighted with this year's results and they are testament to the teaching, tracking processes and overall care for each individual student we have in place to ensure that students, of all abilities, meet their fullest potential. We do not stand still and are continually striving to ensure that we exhort everyone in the school, teachers and students alike, to give of their best".

In A Level English 76.9% of grades were A*/A with 100% of all grades at A*- B. In Further Mathematics 83% of students achieved A*- B grades, Mathematics 80% and Economics 93%.

Out of the twenty subjects registered at the College, St Edmund's achieved twelve subjects above the world average and three on parity with it in relation to points gained in each respective subject.

44% of our A Level results this year were graded A or A*.
