These are the main team sports played at St Edmund's and we expect our scholars to represent St Edmund's College in these sports at 1st team standard. We encourage our scholars to play for outside clubs and we will support this as far as possible, but the scholar must always be available for College fixtures in the first instance, including Saturday fixtures. Occasional absence may be granted due to major tournaments etc., however, this will be at the discretion of the Director of Sport.

Candidates will be tested on their overall fitness and their potential to play in at least one of our team sports mentioned above.

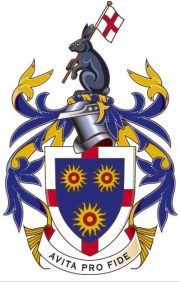
#### **Scholarship Assessment Day**

Candidates will undertake a thorough set of fitness tests to rate their co-ordination, flexibility, agility, power and also their overall cardio-vascular fitness. They will be required to demonstrate skills and technical knowledge in their chosen sport (St Edmund's main games) and they may be asked to lead part of the session. Candidates will also be interviewed on the day.

**Candidates participating in hockey, football and/or rugby will require all appropriate safety equipment (shin guards, gum shields and suitable footwear) if candidates do not have these they will not be allowed to participate.**
