



MOCK EXAMINATIONS - JANUARY 2023

INFORMATION SHEET FOR STUDENTS & PARENTS

Mock examinations for Poetry and Rhetoric 2 will start on Monday 9th January.

Timetables are published on the VLE, the College website and Notice Boards in and around the College. **If you think you may have a clash, please see Mrs Waite no later than Monday 21st November.** If you know that you will be absent for an examination for any reason, please inform your Housemaster/Housemistress and Mrs Waite via email no later than Friday 9th December.

For all examination candidates -

- Please make sure you are aware of the venue for your examination.
- If you normally sit your examinations separately, please wait with the other students outside the main venue – you will be collected by an invigilator and taken to your own venue.
- Please make sure that you arrive at the venue **at least 10 minutes** before the published start time which is 9.00am for morning sessions and 1.30pm for afternoon sessions. Some examinations start at 11.30am – again, you must arrive at the venue at least 10 minutes beforehand.
- Combined Science GCSE examinations start at 9.30am or 2pm. If you are taking Combined Science, you must arrive by 8.50am or 1.20pm and you will be able to revise in the venue before your examination starts. Only notes or one textbook can be brought in no bags or large folders.
- Please make sure that you have all the equipment & stationery items you will need in a clear pencil case. We cannot provide **any** equipment to students.
- Mock examinations are conducted under the same conditions as public examinations so please make sure that you do not have any unauthorised materials with you – **this includes all watches as well as mobile phones, etc.** Leave all your belongings in your locker, **no bags will be allowed in the examination rooms.**

Under no circumstances will you be able to leave the examination early – make sure that you have everything that you might need with you and that you have used the toilet before your examination begins.

For Rhetoric Students –

If you do not have a timetabled examination, you should attend lessons as normal

For Poetry Students –

- If you do not have an examination, you will study in the Maths classrooms Please check the registers for your room allocation.

Normal lessons for Rhetoric 2 students will resume on Monday 23rd January, and for Poetry students Wednesday 25th January.
