The Cardinal Allen Art Scholarship is for talented artists who, ideally, intend to study Art in Sixth Form. Those who receive Art Scholarships will be expected to make a significant contribution to Art at the College throughout their time here. They will be required to support the academic and enrichment programme.

PERSONAL PORTFOLIO

Students should bring a portfolio of their own artwork with them. It should include a selection of two-dimensional work in any media and photographs of any three-dimensional work they have made. We will be looking for evidence of skillful handling of the formal elements of the visual language and a wide engagement with creative visual expression.

GCSE SKETCHBOOKS

Students should bring examples of their current GCSE sketchbooks/portfolio with them. This should show evidence of a range of investigative/experimental techniques and how these have been used to develop a final piece. As part of this work students should show evidence of an investigation into an artist's practice and a personal response to their work. We will be looking for evidence of contextual awareness and the ability to interpret others' work, both visually and in words.

SCHOLARSHIP EXAMINATION

On the day of the examination, students will be given a set of drawing tasks to complete. They will be given all the materials required on the day. We will be looking for evidence of skillful handling of the formal elements in a variety of media, and the ability to observe and record visual information accurately and effectively. Students will also be interviewed on the day.
