ST EDMUND'S UNIFORM LIST RHETORIC (Sixth Form) - GIRLS

It is expected that Rhetoricians will set an impeccable standard of dress at all times. Please note that suits are not available from the College Retail Specialist, Stevensons. Please read all *three* pages.

There are three options:

A plain, businesslike, dark grey, navy blue or black skirt suit with lapels – knee or calf length (wool or wool mix). **Short, tight skirts are not permitted. Skirts which are thigh length are not permitted. Jersey skirts are not permitted. Skirts should be a formal cut, with a waistband and zip.**

A plain dark grey, navy blue or black waistcoat (optional).

A plain, dark coloured, v-necked, fine pullover (optional). **Sloppy, long and baggy jumpers are not permitted. Jumpers should not be over-long. If worn these should not clash with blouse or tie - overtly clashing colours are not permitted.**

A white or coloured blouse with a collar. Worn buttoned with a house or College tie, or worn open-necked. **Chiffon, see-through, diaphanous, low cut, revealing blouses are not permitted**

Black or navy opaque tights.

Natural coloured tights (Trinity and first half of Michaelmas term only).

Black or navy sensible and comfortable shoes. **Canvas shoes and trainers are not permitted.**

or

A plain, businesslike, dark grey, navy blue or black trouser suit. **Please note that trousers should match the jacket exactly - blazers are not permitted. Trousers should not be skinny jeans, jeggings or leggings, they should not have rivets or patch pockets, and should not be too tight fitting. Jackets should have lapels.**

A plain dark grey, navy blue or black waistcoat (optional).

A plain, dark coloured, fitted v-necked, fine pullover (optional) - **sloppy, long and baggy jumpers are not permitted. Jumpers should not be over-long. If worn these should not clash with blouse or tie - overtly clashing colours are not permitted.**

A white or coloured blouse with a collar. Worn buttoned with a house or College tie, or worn open-necked. **Chiffon, see-through, diaphanous, low cut, revealing blouses are not permitted**

A House or College badge (available from the College).

Black or navy opaque tights.

Natural coloured tights (Trinity and first half of Michaelmas term only).

Black or navy sensible and comfortable shoes. Canvas shoes and trainers are not permitted.

or

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A plain, businesslike, dark grey, navy blue, or black shift dress (**worn as close to the knee as possible - not thigh length**) - dresses worn at mid-thigh length are not permitted. Short jersey dresses which flare out at the bottom are not permitted, dresses should be of a good quality in terms of the weight of the fabric and should not be short. All dresses should be plain.

A matching jacket with lapels.

A plain, dark coloured, round necked fine knit cardigan (optional). **Long cardigans are not permitted.**

Black, or navy opaque tights.

Natural coloured tights (Trinity and first half of Michaelmas term only)

Black or navy sensible and comfortable shoes. **Canvas shoes and trainers are not permitted.**

Fashion suits are not permitted. Please consult with the Head of Rhetoric before purchasing an expensive item that may not be suitable.

Please also note that regular uniform checks will be carried out by tutors and students who do not conform to the policy will be asked to change their clothing.

Please note that if a student comes to school wearing a skirt which is too tight, too short and does not exactly match her jacket (as in suit) or if she is wearing leggings, skinny jeans or anything which can not be described as a smart trouser, she will be asked to change into a Rhetoric skirt which she will wear at school until she attends suitably attired in her own clothes.
